

12. In keeping with (11) the newsletter is for members only.
13. The only case where women are permitted to run with the BH3 is on overnight outstation runs where a wife or girlfriend may accompany a BH3 member.
14. Hares will seek out new areas further afield than the areas where weekday kennels hash.
15. Running at the initial start of a BH3 hash is frowned upon.....better to çstart slowly and taper offé.
16. We do not race on the hash and there is no winner.
17. Shortcutting is not a crime.
18. Taking motorized transport during the run is a crime.
19. No poofers on the BH3.
20. We do not sit while the circle is in progress.
21. We do not sit on ice.
22. We are a singing hash.
23. We sing 'He's a 'bastard' so they say' (not 'hasher' or 'hash shit').
24. We sing 'He's no 'fucking use' to anyone' (not 'jolly good').
25. Sinners are given down downs for things that happen on the run (not because of sports, religious, or political events in the news).
26. Political correctness is not encouraged.
27. We dine together at a single joined row of tables whenever possible.
28. We collectively pay as a group for beers we consume and food we eat.
29. Wine or whiskey brought to the dinner table should be shared amongst all.
30. Falling asleep at the dinner table is perfectly acceptable.
31. Every member has done 'the steel' on joining BH3.
32. In addition to setting one run a year Hares are expected to do one write-up for the newsletter.

Let me start by giving my thanks to Bangcook and Hema who, as Cash Ass, did sterling work in filling in for me on my numerous absences on Saturdays, and a special thanks for Khun Tiradej for stepping up to the plate when all three "Cashes" were missing.

The year started with Baht 36995 in the kitty but although our costs have increased during the year, we have managed to hold both the quarterly and weekly subs at Baht 2300 and Baht 300 respectively, yet as we enter the last couple of weeks of the reign of "Anal Rape", our financial position stands at Baht 98,000. Before you all rub your hands in glee in anticipation of a lot of freebies, we have got some expenses to budget for. Obviously the AGPU takes a goodly amount but also we have our 2000th Run due in September, which will also be receiving subsidies from the "kitty".
